The National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) is an autonomous organisation set up in 1961 by the Government of India to assist and advise the Central and State Governments on policies and programmes for qualitative improvement in school education. The major objectives of NCERT and its constituent units are to: undertake, promote and coordinate research in areas related to school education; prepare and publish model textbooks, supplementary material, newsletters, journals and develops educational kits, multimedia digital materials, etc. organise pre-service and in-service training of teachers; develop and disseminate innovative educational techniques and practices; collaborate and network with state educational departments, universities, NGOs and other educational institutions; act as a clearing house for ideas and information in matters related to school education; and act as a nodal agency for achieving the goals of Universalisation of Elementary Education. In addition to research, development, training, extension, publication and dissemination activities, NCERT is an implementation agency for bilateral cultural exchange programmes with other countries in the field of school education. The NCERT also interacts and works in collaboration with the international organisations, visiting foreign delegations and offers various training facilities to educational personnel from developing countries. The major constituent units of NCERT which are located in different regions of the country are:

- National Institute of Education (NIE) and Central Institute of Educational Technology (CIET) located at New Delhi
- Pandit Sundarlal Sharma Central Institute of Vocational Education (PSSCIVE) at Bhopal; and
- Regional Institutes of Education (RIEs) at Ajmer, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Mysore and Shillong

Regional Institute of Education (RIE), Mysuru

The Regional Institute of Education (formerly known as Regional College of Education), Mysuru established on 1st August, 1963 with main objective of qualitative improvement of school education through innovative pre-service and in-service teacher training programmes and relevant research, development and extension activities.

RIE has established itself as an institute of repute in the area of school and teacher Education. The institute has endeavoured to shoulder the responsibilities and challenges generated by changes in the educational scenario of the country and the southern region. The Institute has been functioning as Regional Institute of Education since 1995, following a major shift in its focus from pre-service Education to in-service Education. The pre-service teacher Education programmes of the institute are affiliated to the University of Mysore, Mysuru and cater to the needs of south Indian states namely Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana and Union Territories of Pondicherry and Lakshadweep. A Demonstration School (DMS) (1-XII Standard) is attached to RIE Mysuru as a laboratory for trying out innovative practices in school Education and teacher Education. A Pre-School is also attached to the DMS admitting children for Play School, LKG and UKG.

The Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi has set up an Inter University Centre for Teacher Education (IUCTE) at the Regional Institute of Education, Mysuru. The IUCTE aims to strengthen the knowledge base of Teacher Education by facilitating professional development, networking, new knowledge creation and empowerment of teachers of Academic Institutions and Central & State Universities in the Southern Region. The Campus is spread over more than 120 acrea with separate Residential Hostel facilities for Boys and Girls, Guest House, Health Centre, Canteen, Sports Ground, Open GIM, etc. The departments of RIE are:

- Department of Education in Science and Mathematics
- Department of Education in Social Sciences
- Department of Education
- Department of Extension Education







Major Functions of RIE

- Designing and implementing innovative pre-service teacher training programmes at various levels.
- Conducting continuing education/in-service training programmes for capacity-building of the staff of DIETs, CTEs, IASEs and SCERTs and other educational functionaries of the States/Union Territories in the region.
- Carrying out research and development activities in various areas of concern of school education and teacher education.
- Offering consultancy on matters related to school education as well as teacher education.
- Providing academic support in school education and teacher education to States and Union Territories in the region.
- Assisting in the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of centrally sponsored schemes in the region.
- Assisting the States in the development, field testing and evaluation of curriculum materials, textbooks and instructional materials.
